Professor Gert Melville is Senior Professor of History at the University of Dresden, where he has taught since 1994. He is the author of four decades of scholarship on religious life, religious orders, and the broader religious and cultural history of the Middle Ages. He is also founder and director of the Research Center for Comparative History of Religious Orders (FOVOG) at the University of Dresden, and over the last 20 years he has been the principal investigator for a series of major research projects under the auspices of the German Research Foundation (DFG).
