Note: The history honors program is open to history majors who have a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0, a 3.3 GPA or above in History, and at least 12 hours of HY courses completed. Students who complete a History Honors thesis by taking the combination of HY 498 and HY 499 are exempt from having to take the HY 430 UG Research Seminar. The thesis must be completed under the direction of a tenured or tenure-track member of the department. Students wishing to complete an Honors thesis must secure approval from their faculty honors advisor before embarking on this process. In order to graduate with honors in history, students must have a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0, a 3.3 GPA or above in history, and satisfactory completion of a thesis judged to merit an honors designation.

Upper Level Course Requirements (at least 12 Hours Earned While in Residency Required)

A minimum of 12 semester hours of 300- and 400-level courses in the major must be earned on this campus. Students must complete 15 semesters hours of 300- and 400-level courses in total.
